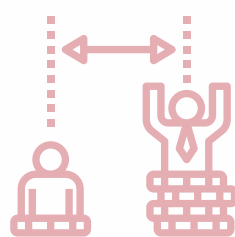
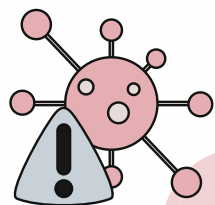
1. Set targets and performance indicators

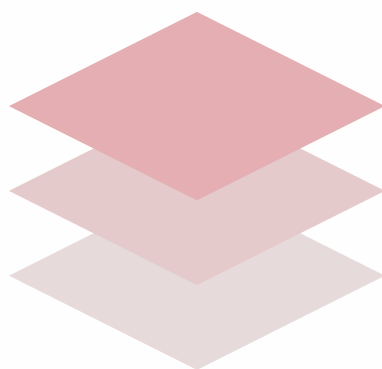

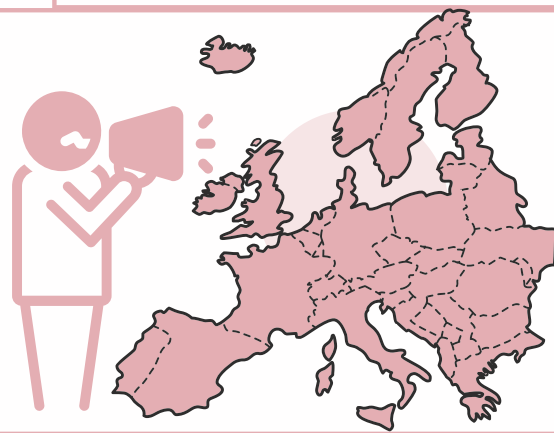
