


How did we use A2D to understand the AVMSD revision process?

- 1. Exploratory use of A2D filling major gaps in publicly available documentation of the policy process
- 2. <u>Deep-dive</u> (iterative) following specific leads

Types of documents requested

- A. Policy documents e.g., draft IAs
- B. Internal processes e.g., inter-service steering group/consultation, RSB
- C. Meetings/correspondence with external stakeholders



Takeaways (from this case & others)

- What comes <u>after</u> the initial request is an important part of the process (but more time-consuming)
- More challenging to obtain information for <u>ongoing policy processes</u> (and those going too far back?)
- Inconsistent redactions worth challenging
- <u>Triangulate</u> A2D results rarely present a full picture
