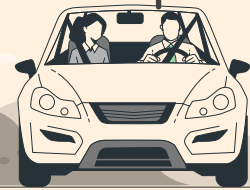

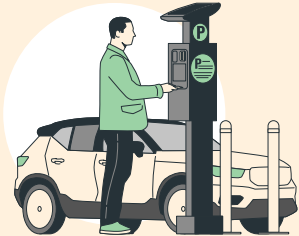

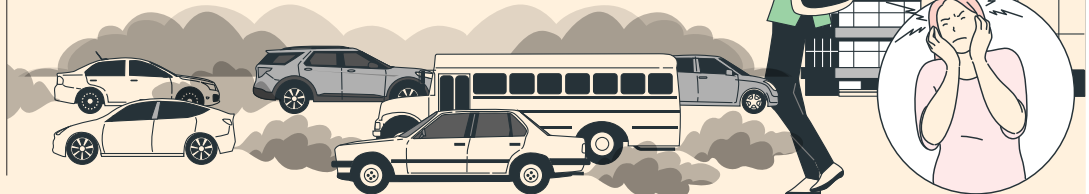
ISSUE

NEGATIVE HEALTH IMPACTS FROM INCREASED AIR POLLUTION AND NOISE POLLUTION



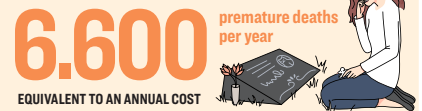
SHOCKINGLY, **ONLY 3.9%** OF TRAVEL WITHIN THE REGION IS BY CAR



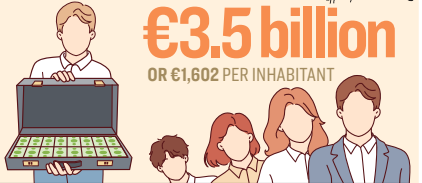
WITH PRIVATE CARS PARKED ON AVERAGE **96%** OF THE TIME

OR €1,602 PER INHABITANT



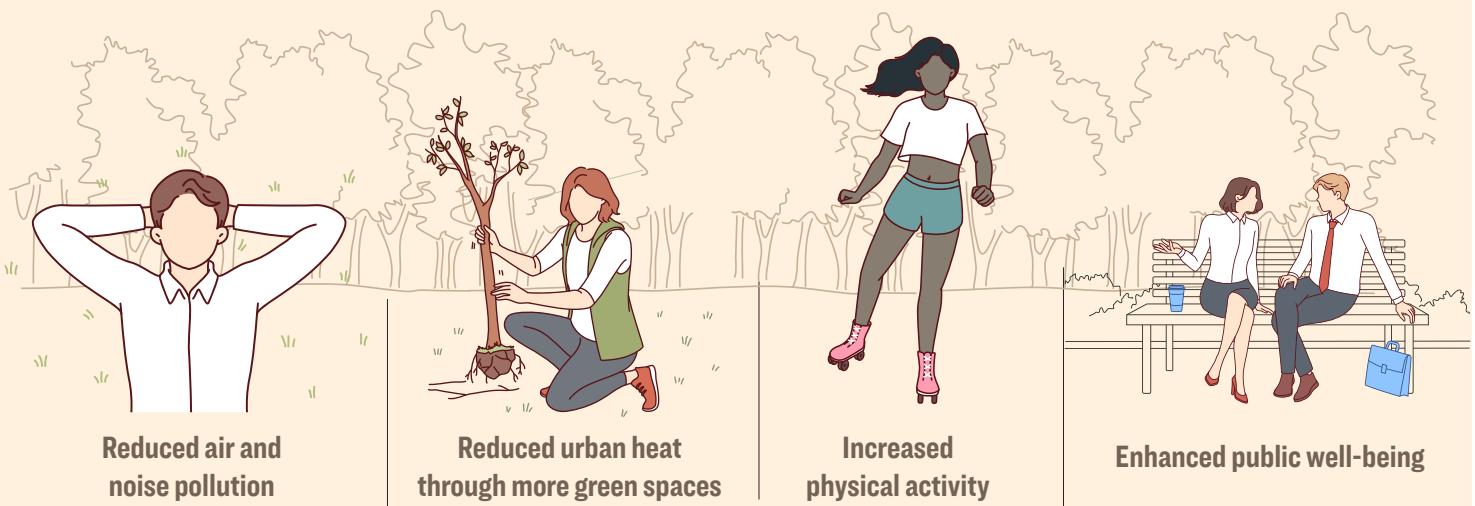
