The **objective of the EPHA workplan 2025 Meeting on 4 December**, is to present these priorities to all members, and to **collate both further feedback and members' interest in concrete collaboration** on these projects.

The document also includes an overview of **EU-funded (Horizon Europe & EU4Health) projects**, and **projects funded by Foundations/Philanthropic organisations**. The activities under these projects are defined under contractual agreements and cannot be amended. Hence, these will not be discussed on 4 December.

Specific actions

- Advocate for the full implementation of the prevention pillar of the Europe's Beating Cancer Plan (alcohol-, tobacco-, unhealthy food-related provisions).
- Support the crafting of a Prevention Pillar of the upcoming "Europe's Cardiovascular Disease Plan", including comprehensive preventive measures focusing on NCD risk factors.
