# **PROFILE** study

Aims to recruit 1500 men - aged 40 to 69 years, (UK)

- 350 men of Black African/Black African-Caribbean ancestry
- 800\* men of any ancestry with a family history of prostate cancer. \*Overrecruiting to get 350 undergoing MRI & biopsy.
- 350 men of any ancestry, who carry rarer high-risk genes for prostate cancer








## **PROFILE Study - Cumulative Recruitment**





Six-monthly Recruitment




## Recruitment challenges to the Black cohort

### What we have done to improve recruitment to this group:

- Introduced the study into Primary Care
- Designed posters and obtained ethical approvals to raise awareness
- Visited public areas such as barber shops, churches, restaurants, pubs, gyms to display posters and raise awareness
- Give awareness talks at community meetings and support groups
- Face a challenge of misinformation; lack of trust amongst the community; cancer a taboo subject; need for **privacy**
- Arranged to have study posters displayed in toilet cubicles (e.g. football stadiums)
- Started a PPI project to co-produce an awareness video with a range of Black men some were PROFILE participants, a PrCa survivor & members of the public. Link: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=A72hCjLN3gE">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=A72hCjLN3gE</a>
- PPI team planned the content of the video, location, some took part in it, and some coauthored the publication

# **Current numbers** recruited via GP practices/Hospitals/ManVan/Awareness

- 1. Men of any ancestry with a Family history of prostate cancer (aim for 800)
- 666\* (\*over-recruiting to this group as we need 350 in the MRI/Biopsy arm 297)
- 2. Men of Black African/ Black African-Caribbean ancestry Group (aim for 350)
- · 330
- 3. Men of any ancestry with a mutation in a high-risk gene (aim for 350)
- · 310

And **30** eligible men - awaiting GP referrals
